Opportunities like this can increase your exposure even more, and when someone is referring to your work it increases the perception of your credibility with readers.

Though, like any good investment, you should do some research before using a submit blog directory. The first thing to look for is easy navigation. If you use a submit blog directory that is hard to sort through then your potential readership probably will not want to sort through it, meaning that your potential readership is no longer looking for you. Take some time to check the content of the other bloggers who use that submit blog directory. Are they updating regularly with high quality content? The only thing worse than no exposure is bad exposure and you do not want your hard work being associated with less than good writing and being disregarded by potential readers. That research can pay off, a good submit blog directory can bring quality readership and revenue that will make your blog that much more enjoyable to write.
