

## Car Polish

Car polish is a coating applied to a cars surface to minimize scratches and give the car a smooth finish. You should only use car polish after you have washed your car. Both liquid car polish and paste car polish have advantages.

Car polish is applied to the surface of a car to erase scratches and smooth out the finish of the car. You can have car polish done professionally at a body shop or car wash or do it yourself.

Car polish and car cleaner polish are not the same thing. Car cleaner polish removes leftover debris such as bug splatter, bird droppings, and minor scratches. Car polish provides protection that can last as long as one year between coats and provides a deep shine to the car.

Car polish should be applied only after you have washed your car. Polish your car in only one spot at time. Apply the polish in a circular motion using a clean microsoft cloth. After the polish has dried, buff the area with a different clean microsoft cloth.

Paste car polish and liquid car polish give about the same results. Paste car polish is applied by hand. Because liquid car polish can be applied by machine, you can polish more cars using liquid car polish. Although paste car polish costs more, it lasts much longer than liquid car polish. See more
