

What Type of Self Storage Unit Do You Need?

Picking the kind of self storage unit you need takes some honesty. Be frank with yourself: How much room will your stored belongings really take up? How fragile are they, and how concerned about their condition will you be while they are in the self storage unit? How frequently are you likely to need to go into the self storage unit to take out and put in items? Selecting a self storage unit with the right dimensions is essential. Take into account not only the space taken up by your boxed belongings, but any extra space you will need. For example, if you plan to pack the unit and leave it packed until you are ready to empty it, you will need a unit just large enough to hold your belongings. However, if you plan to use the unit as long term storage and visit periodically to take out boxes and put new objects in, you will need extra space for aisles. You may even need space for shelving, both to make it easier to find your belongings and to protect delicate objects.

Picking the optimum level of climate control is also essential. Many possessions, like modern dishware and cooking utensils, modern rugs, many objects made of metal, and anything made of stone or concrete, do not need temperature control. However, heat damages antiques, art, books, and some textiles. Anything containing liquid can shatter in the cold. Especially delicate items, like some antiques and art, need humidity control as well. When you decide whether you need a unit with climate control, consider the age of your possessions, what they are made of, and how fragile they are. Your peace of mind is also essential. If the condition of your possessions in the self storage unit is likely to weigh on your mind, choosing a unit with climate control may help you put your worries to rest.

Factor in all the details of your case, and take into account your comfort and convenience as you use your self storage unit. With a little care and realism, you are sure to pick the right kind of self storage unit for you.
